FROM SAN ANTONIO TO ROUND MOUNTAIN GOETH'S RANCH AND BACK-90.0 MILES.

Logged by Dr. R. A. Goeth.

00.0 At courthouse, going up Avenue C, River Avenue and then into Wetmore road.
12.6 WETMORE. After passing the railway station take the left-hand road going north on the macadamized road.
22.0 Take right-hand road at an open flat. The left-hand road goes to Bulverde over quite a high mountain ridge, while the right-hand road goes around the end of this ridge and strikes road from Bulverde to New Braunfels.
27.6 Right in the bed of the Cibolo. Follow the New Braunfels road to the right.
28.1 Take the left-hand road. The right-hand road goes to New Braunfels.
33.7 You get into the Boerne-New Braunfels Road. Follow to the right.
34.6 Blanco_New Braunfels Road, turning sharp corner to the north. At this point it is easy to make mis take and run down toward New Braunfels. Going north you pass Smithson's Valley.
35.5 Take the left-hand road, as the right-hand road goes to Fisher's store. The New Braunfels-Blanco Road is well worked, but has many short and highwater sheds or ditches across it. If the road overseer would make his ditches across the road wider, as they are made at most every other place, they would not be so hard on buggy springs. Judge Wurzbach of Seguin complained of these same bumps in that road.
40.1 Guadalupe River bridge. This would be a fine place for a club run and picnic at some falls about three hundred yards above the bridge.
42.3 Take right-hand road. The left-hand goes to Spring Branch.
43.6 Road from San Antonio via Specht's crossing on the GuadalupeRiver comes in from the left.
50.0 TWIN SISTERS, store and cotton gin.
59.0 BLANCO CITY. Gasoline.
73.2 JOHNSON CITY. Go through eastern edge of town, past schoolhouse and east corner.
76.5 Road through gate on the right hand to go to Goeth's ranch and Cypress Mill through the pastures. The road goes through many gates and

is very rough in many places, but you avoid one bad mile loose sand on the road to Round Moun tain.
S5.0 ROUND MOUNTAIN. Go right through town, going east. At the eastern edge of town the road to Marble Falls is the main road going out and turns off to the left from the end of the main street. To go to Goeth's ranch take the righthand road, going due east into a lane.
89.0 Lane turning to left going due north.
90.0 Goeth's ranch, large 2 -story rock house, about on $\theta$ hundred yards to right of lane. From here it is about twelve miles to Marble Falls.

## FROM ROUND MOUNTAIN.

00.0 ROUND MOUNTAIN. Going west on the main street, turn to left at end of street, and follow main road, going south. Between the sixth and seventh mile there is one mile of heavy sand.
11.8 JOHNSON CITY. Pass through eastern edge of town, past the schoolhouse.

26.0 BLANCO CITY. From the courthouse in the plaza go east across the Blanco River. Water is always very shallow.
